

Guidelines regarding installation of Solar systems in Arrowhead Shores

No Construction may be commenced prior to Architectural Control Committee (ACC) approval.

1. Installation contractor/company must be recognized by the state of Texas as a licensed Solar Installation Company.
2. Home Owner must be aware of any regulatory concerns with Tri-County Electric Co-Operative, Inc The electric provider for Arrowhead Shores.
3. Homeowner should contract his insurance company to ensure that the solar installation does not impact the insurability of the home.
4. Provide as much construction/ installation detail as possible (plans, building materials list, contractor names if owner is not the GC).
5. After ACC approval you have 6 months to complete the project ,You must provide an estimated start date to the ACC.
6. If any questions arise during the installation of your solar system, please contact the ACC. Specifically, if you will not be able to complete your construction on schedule.
7. Maintain a neat appearance of your construction site during construction phase. Dispose of waste in a timely manner.
